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# What is a wiki

- A wiki is an easy tool to create your project pages quick and in a structured manner.
- The content is created without any defined owner or leader.
- The structure emerges according to the needs of the users.

In a formal way:

- It is a knowledge base website. Like the FAQs of a website. Is a centralized database for spreading information and data. Knowledge bases support collecting, organizing, retrieving, and sharing knowledge.
- It uses a simplified markup language.
- Is a FLOSS tool: Free/Libre Open Source Software (can be copy, modify, customize, etc).
- Users collaboratively modify and structure content directly from a web browser.(red links - Wikipedia Edit-a-thon)

# Examples

- The online encyclopedia project Wikipedia is the most popular wiki-based website, and is one of the most widely viewed sites in the world, having been ranked in the top ten since 2007
- Wikipedia is not a single wiki but rather a collection of hundreds of wikis. There are many different wikis specialized on different things.
- Ward Cunningham, the developer of the first wiki software, WikiWikiWeb, originally described wiki as "the simplest online database that could possibly work".
- wiki is a Hawaiian word meaning "quick"

## Why to use a wiki

- Permits many users to modify the same document (Not to write in the same moment!)
- It structures the information in a very easy way
- Easy to start working on it and to achieve documentation for projects from scratch
- Directly from a web browser, you don't need additional apps or download any other program.
- Horizontal organization

- The "Amen Break" six- seconds drum sample.
- This fascinating, brilliant 20-minute video narrates the history of the "Amen Break," a six-second drum sample from the b-side of a chart-topping single from 1969.
- This sample was used extensively in early hiphop and sample-based music, and became the basis for drum-and-bass and jungle music -- a six-second clip that spawned several entire subcultures. Nate Harrison's 2004 video is a meditation on the ownership of culture, the nature of art and creativity, and the history of a remarkable music clip.

- Markup languages are the building blocks used to present the content.
- A markup language is a “code” that we use to “format” text.
- HTML: Hipertextual Markup Language = WEB
- Wikitext = Wiki markup = Wikicode
